The Henry George Foundation

We have received copies of a neat booklet containing the Deed of Trust of the Henry George Foundation of Australia, together with some account of its objects and work.

The Foundation was established at Melbourne, July, 1928, by Edgar William Culley, Doctor of Osteopathy, with a gift of £20,000, "for the purpose of promulgating and spreading the knowledge of the teachings and economic principles of Henry George as elaborated by him in *Progress and Poverty* and other of his works."

The Constitution which is contained in the Deed of Trust provides for the permanency of the Foundation. In its preparation the founder took into consultation a number of followers of Henry George.

The Deed was signed by Edgar William Culley, as Founder of the Trust, and by each of the original 21 Trustees appointed by him. It was registered by P. J. Markham, as Secretary *pro tem*, and was approved and signed by the Registrar-General for Victoria on Saturday, 14th July, 1928.

The Trustees are empowered to administer the Fund laid down, and to receive and administer any other funds or property, whether gifts or bequests, and the Inaugural Meeting of the Trust was held on Thursday, 12th July, 1928.

The Foundation is not an active propagandist body, but rather, a receiving and distributing agency. The Deed of Gift provides that only the income from the Foundation Fund shall be utilized—the Fund remaining intact—and already the Trustees have voted about £900 to various Henry George Leagues.

Though not carrying on activities such as the Leagues, the Foundation is interesting itself in the literature of the Land Values Movement, and is communicating with England and America regarding books on the subject. It has ordered from America a number of sets of the Library Edition of *The Life and Complete Works of Henry George* for presentation to each of the Australian State Universities.

In this connection the Foundation is also offering a prize of £10 to each State University for an Essay on Henry George's teaching, and a further £10 for the best among the winners in the State Competitions.

Besides this the Foundation is offering, through the Henry George Leagues, prizes for the best short leaflets presenting phases of the Single Tax objective.

The Trustees of the Foundation are well-known men in the Georgeian Movement selected from each of the Australian States; but, the establishment being made at Melbourne, the Victorian quota is the largest.

Mr W. H. Renwick, President, now on his way to the International Single Tax Conference at Edinburgh, will speak for the Foundation at the Conference.

Mr P. J. Markham is Secretary, and the office of the Foundation is at Henry George Club Room, 18, George Parade, Melbourne.

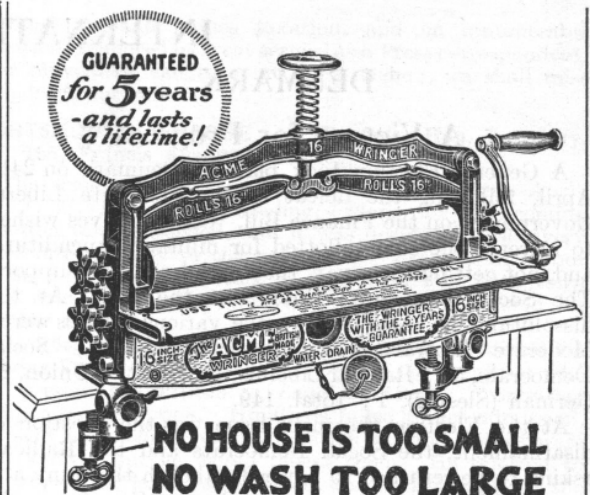
