Visiting speakers from abroad will include Ashley Mitchell, V. H. Blundell and V. G. Saldji of England; J. H. and K. J. Kristensen of Denmark; Gustav Bohnsack of Germany, and others who will bring reports from various European, African and Asian

countries, as well as Australia, Canada, the Caribbean and Latin America.
