

1915-09-02 Henry George Adherents To Visit His Birthplace

In commemoration of the seventy-sixth anniversary of the birth of Henry George, founder of the single tax movement, members of the Philadelphia Single Tax Society will make a "twilight pilgrimage" to 413 South Tenth street at 6:30 o'clock this evening and on the pavement hold a short memorial meeting. It was in this house that Henry George was born.

It is expected that many exponents of the single tax theory will be in attendance. Addresses will be made by the members.

The meeting will be presided over by the chairman, W. L. Ross.

Later in the evening there will be a meeting at the headquarters of the society, in Filbert street near Broad. On Saturday afternoon the event will also be celebrated at Arden, Del., a community which was established to carry out the theory of Henry George. There will be addresses by the residents of the town and also by visitors.

The little home on South Tenth street is owned by Dr. Thomas S. K. Morton, a member of the society, who purchased the property to preserve it.
