

JULIAN P. HICKOK

We are sorry to report the death of Julian P. Hickok on May 27. He was 91 and had been living in Vermont. He had been closely associated with the Georgist movement in Philadelphia and was the founder of the Henry George School extension in that city in 1935. By profession he was an engineer and he was active in politics. But it was as a teacher of economics that the Philadelphia Bulletin featured him in its obituary. Mr. Hickok fully endorsed the principle that "the earth is the birthright of all mankind" but was committed to land value taxation as the only practical method that has been put forward. He worked out mathematically how land value taxation could progressively be put into practice.
