## RAYMOND CROTTY

IU member Raymond Crotty of Dublin, Ireland, died on January 1. In 1955, following an IU Conference, Robert Clancy, the Menningers of Chicago and Casserley of Dublin toured Ireland. They stopped at Kilkenny to visit Raymond Crotty who had recently contacted the IU, expressing interest in the Georgist philosophy. He was a farmer at the time, but soon after he quit farming because the Irish government made it too difficult with regulations and taxes. He pursued an academic career, studying at Aberystwyth College in Wales. Eventually he became a research fellow in the Department of Statistics at Trinity College, Dublin. He did important work on land statistics. He attended IU conferences and submitted papers.
