## George E. Evans

George E. Evans, chairman of the Pittsburgh Housing Authority which spent \$20,000,000 on slum clearance, died on June 8, 1945.

A native of Freeport, Ohio, Mr. Evans was graduated from Exeter Academy at Exeter, N. H., and received his law degree from the University of Pittsburgh.

In 1934 he was appointed chairman of the Pittsburgh Housing Committee.

Mr. Evans was former president of the National Association of Housing Officials, past president of the Pennsylvania Lumber Dealers' Association, chairman of the Pennsylvania State Housing Board and former president of the Henry George Foundation of America.
