Staff writer Charles Hillinger interviewed Mayor Jim Nix as well as single taxers Sam Dyson and Gale Rowe.

The media network response to the U.S. Catholic Bishops' Statement on Capitalism garnered several news items. Earl Hanson of Utahns for Tax Reform converted the release to an op-ed piece which ran in two local papers. Similar coverage was given in Philadelphia's Germantown Courier. The Long Island Catholic made reference to the Georgist response in a compendium of reactions to the Bishops' letter.
