Following the Wilmington Delaware City election of last June at which time the Pittsburgh plan was made a plank of the Democratic Party Platform it was decided that commencing this fall free classes in the Henry George School would be conducted under the auspices of the Democratic City Committee.

Through the cooperation of Mr. W. S. Potter, Democratic State chairman, Mr. J. C. Hazzard, City chairman; Dr. Henry George, and M. Joseph Stockman of the Henry George School, the City Commerce and the City League were approached and following their approval the first class was held October 14th in the City Committee rooms at 612 French Street.

As teachers for the three classes in Fundamental Economics, International Trade and Democracy vs. Socialism the Delaware Democrats will have Dr. Henry George, Francis Q. Lemon and John F. Newell.

This is the first time in the State of Delaware that a major political party has undertaken the serious study of Henry George in the effort to educate their committees and ward workers to fundamental economics.
