The Henry George School has recently acquired, through gifts, a number of valuable items. Mrs. Gertrude Baker has donated a life-size painting of her husband, Robert Baker, also some fine books from his library. The late Mr. Baker was a member of Congress and a Georgist.

Mrs. Teresa Burger has donated items from the collection of the late Benjamin W. Burger, recently deceased. The outstanding one was the death mask of Henry George. Other items were a set of the Edinburgh Review from 1800 to 1840, and some early editions of Henry George's works, including one autographed by the author.

Mrs. Norman Allmayer has donated books from the library of her aunt, the late Mrs. Mary Fels. Some of the books were from the original library of Joseph Fels, her husband, and bear his signature.

Another collection of interesting books was donated by Mrs. Eva Goldstein. These and other recent gifts are welcome additions to the school's growing library. During the week of August 20th an impressive and valuable collection of Standards, edited by Henry George, was left in the library by an unknown donor.
