We regret to announce the death of Erich Zincke of Hanover, West Germany, on August 14 at the age of eighty. To his wife we extend our heartfelt sympathy. The following tribute is by Gustav Bohnsack.

FRRIENDS in all the five continents will mourn the loss of Erich Zincke whose knowledge, understanding and devotion did so much to aid the advocacy of the cause he held dear. His translation of *Progress and Poverty* into German will remain a testimonial to his ability and dedication.

With his scientific publications and especially with his translation of *Progress and Poverty* he has made more accessible to German readers the ideas of Henry George. His last paper was published in April 1969 in the *American Journal of Economics and Sociology*.

Erich Zincke was a host to many Georgists on their visits to West Germany and he did much to make the Hanover Conference of the International Union in 1959 a success with his practical help and suggestions. The International Union for Land-Value Taxation and Free Trade chose him to be the Vice President for West Germany.

I am losing a fatherly friend who opened to me the many opportunities of association and friendship among members of the International Union for Land-Value Taxation and Free Trade. To him I owe much.—
