SEVEN IN MAYOR'S RACE.

Single Tax Party Files Last Petition for Joseph D. Miller.

A seventh candidate for Mayor appeared last night when the Single Tax Party filed with the Board of Election a nominating petition for Joseph Dana Miller as candidate for that office. George R. Macey for Controller and Morris Van Veen for President of the Aldermanic Board. Nominating petitions also were filed by the Single Taxers on behalf of candidates for most borough and county offices. There were 2.100 signatures affixed to the petitions for candidates in Manhattan, 1,650 for those in Brooklyn and 2,000 in Queens.

The other Mayoralty candidates will represent the Democratic, Coalition, Socialist, Prohibition, Farmer-Labor and

Workers' League groups.

A petition with 2,390 names was filed on behalf of Michael E. Buckley of 1,360 Putnam Avenue as independent candidate for Sheriff of Kings County. Robert Lewis Waring, a negro, of 220 East 137th Street, filed a petition containing 1.584 signatures as an independent candidate for member of the Assembly from the Twenty-first Assembly District in Manhattan.
