

## Single Tax Group To Put Attorney's Name On Ballot.

Single-tax advocates yesterday announced they would enter the Democratic Presidential primaries with Attorney William N. McNair, of Pittsburgh, as their candidate. McNair's name will be placed on the primary ballot in various states having primary elections, a local committee, headed by William B. Foster, with F. W. Maguire as secretary, announced. McNair may make a campaign tour if the response to the single-tax announcement justifies it, he said.

"We feel that the single-tax program should be put into active politics as the only remedy yet put forward to end the depression," the newest Presidential candidate said. "None of the candidates so far has advocated a remedy, and the single-tax advocates feel that if states and municipalities can be induced to stop taxing everything in sight, the plan to collect economic rent would relieve industry sufficiently to allow it to get a start upward again."

A resolution of the committee, headed by Foster and Maguire, declared that "the only hope for our country lies in the success of the Democratic party and in the election of a Democratic President."
