ERNEST HOWARD CROSBY, author, social reformer; born New York, November 4, 1856, graduate University New York, 1876; Columbia College Law School, 1878; in law practice, New York, 1878-89; member New York Assembly, 1887-9; nominated by President Harrison and appointed by Khedive judge international court, Alexandria, Egypt, 1889; resigned 1894, and returned to New York. Has since devoted attention to social reform; one of founders and first president Social Reform Club, 1894; president New York Anti-Imperialist League, 1900-4. Author: Plain Talk in Psalm and Parable; Captain Jinks, Hero; Swords and Plowshares; Tolstoy and His Message; Tolstoy as a Schoolmaster; Broad-Cast; Garrison, the Non-Resistant; etc.
