



### A Page from Our Album

Robert C. Macauley and Richard C. Barnum were candidates for President and Vice-President of the United States on the Single Tax party ticket of 1920. These photographs were recently donated to the Henry George School by Mr. Barnum of Cleveland. There was one other national ticket in 1924, but in that year the name was changed to the Commonwealth Land party. The candidates in 1924 were William J. Wallace for President and John C. Lincoln for Vice-President. Mr. Lincoln is President of the Henry George School and lives in Phoenix, Arizona.

The photograph below shows one of the first telephone poles being erected in an unidentified town early in the century. Across the wall of the house appears a huge advertisement for Henry George cigars, with a picture of Henry George and the quotation, "I am for men."
