JOS. MCGUINNESS

JOSEPH MCGUINNESS, born March 1855 in old 11th Ward of New York City; educated in catholic parochial schools; actively supported Henry George in all his campaigns; president Eastern District Single Tax Club, (Brooklyn) 1889-1890; debated tariff question with Col. Chas. Morton. 1892, Brooklyn Times and Standard Union (Protectionist) conceding the victory to him; president first Municipal Ownership League organized in Brooklyn, 1895; Chief Bureau of Licenses for Brooklyn, 1902-1904; Private Secretary, Congressman Robt. Baker since 1904. Author of several pamphlets; "Why and How"; "The Small House Owners of Greater New York."
