The subject for discussion was "Profit-sharing," as viewed from various points. Mr. Horace L. Traubel read a very interesting paper, "Notes and General Principles." This was followed by an address by Mr. Joseph Gilbert, in which he claimed that profit-sharing would be no advance upon the present wage system. Mr. G. F. Stephens then discussed the subject from the position of a believer in the single tax, or Henry George theory. Mr. Joseph Fels, who was to give "The Views of a Profit-sharing Manufacturer," was unable through illness to be present. After the reading of the paper and the addresses of Messrs. Gilbert and Stephens, the president threw open the meeting to general discussion, in which several persons took part. The chairman having given his views on the various methods at issue the club adjourned after one of the most instructive evenings of the course.
